A story on digitalization, the hunger for more and at the same time the need to stand still, freeze for a moment and reflect.





Once upon a time....

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





two hearts driven tandem two hearts drumming anthems


through one life composing onward two hearts sing in concert



"two bodies spiral backwards" To Spiral backwards (42h x 52b) Blue charcoal on Japanese paper








"two bodies integrating" Integrating (42h x 52b) Blue charcoal on Japanese paper

And they lived....

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

About



In4Art was founded in 2015 to shine a spotlight on young, talented artists and build an internationally appealing art collection filled with works from the artists we support. Our collection is an open collection that is spread over the houses of In4Art members and that is actively put on display during exhibitions throughout Europe. The main focus are the visions and perspectives from artists on our fast-changing society marked by the exponential growth of technological possibilities. we are interested in how the artists translate this to the work they make.

What we do is threefold:


- We support the artists in our collection by giving them commissions, offering them exhibitions combined with residency and offering them business coaching. These are the main blocks of our **incubation program for artists**. The incubation program is free of charge for the artists.
- 2. We expand our collection, of which individuals can become a member. By becoming a member, they support young artists and are offered a low barrier way to get accustomed within the artworld. A first step to become a collector. The members receive several collection pieces in their home and enrol the **Open Collection Membership track** where they are invited for openings, events and salons. The membership fee is mainly utilized to create a revolving fund from which we can commission artists.
- 3. We conduct innovation projects in which we connect the worlds of art, technology and business development. Example is our in4Art Features: a talk show format created for business congresses or symposia to inspire and provoke a discussion on the impact of our fast-changing society, where artists and (start-up) entrepreneurs/ business managers are united. This often leads to very interesting outcomes.

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
